


ECO TOP CUTTER 3000

The Eco Top Cutter 3000-EX in its explosion protected version is applied for cold-cutting of high-pressure natural gas and gas oil pipelines made of steel with a wall thickness up to 40 mm in a pressureless and flowless state, however – where applicable – exposed to an explosive fuel gas/air atmosphere in the interior of the pipeline.


